From the Pastor's Desk

Have you ever heard of the Christmas Truce of 1914? This verified event exemplifies the true miracle of Christmas. World War I, the war to end all wars, was being waged across Europe; it was beyond comprehension in its savagery and violence. On Christmas Eve and Christmas Day of 1914 the German troops begin to put out lights and trees along the top of their trenches. This was all unofficial; there were no orders or plans for this to occur and it took place over several hundred miles of the Western Front. The Germans invited the Allied soldiers to the middle of no man's land where they sang Christmas Carols and held church services. At several places friendly soccer matches were held and gifts from home shared with others. No shots were fired nor were any incidents of violence reported.

The next day when officers ordered the troops to fire at each other they refused. Officers eventually

threatened to shoot troops not firing at the enemy to which many replied, "But they are not the enemy they are our friends". For several days no one was injured as the men shot high over the heads of the troops in the opposing line; one Allied soldier wrote home saying nothing was in danger but the stars overhead for several days. Imagine - the peace of Christ stopping a war, preserving life and making friends of enemies. Oh that the peace of Christ would invade our world again this year causing reconciliation and healing. We sing in the song, Let there be peace on earth and let it begin with me; but do we really mean it? If so, let's begin to act like it this Christmas Season and extend the peace of Christ to everyone throughout the coming year. The spirit of Christmas is to be lived each day of life not just for a few days or weeks. The Christmas Spirit is to transform the heart of men to mirror the heart of a God who gave up his throne in heaven so He could be with His people forever.
