We are behind on our liability & property insurance payments. We have been offered a payoff of \$30,000 for our past-due premiums of \$45,000, this payment will not affect on our lightning claim. Carol Davis moves to have Finance be looking at several ways of coming up with this \$30,000 by January 1, 2012, Faye Fields 2<sup>nd</sup>, APPROVED
