# Using a Quick Response Code (QRC)

We are starting to include Lake Gibson Methodist Church's QRC within our weekly worship bulletin. These are generally accessible through your camera application on smartphones and tablets. If it does not read the QRC directly, it is likely that your camera application has the Scan feature turned off. Once the scan feature is turned on within your settings, your camera should read the QRC directly or provide you with a hyperlink, which when clicked, will open the web-page linked to the QRC (see the below example). Give it a try now to insure that your phone is setup to use this capability.

This specific QRC takes you to the General Operating Budget line item. We encourage you to make your contributions primarily to this line item as it supports keeping the doors open. The Church Council can also move funds with the Genera Operating Budget to meet our immediate needs. There is also a clickable option which reads " ß View other opportunities ". This option takes you to all our other reserved funds, often referred to as "designated funds" which can only support these specific programs. These cannot be reprogrammed without your permission.

# Easter Egg Hunt

The church will be holding the annual Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, March 23, 2024 from 10 AM until Noon. It is intended for children up to the age of 12. There will be two search areas, one for younger children within the ALBOH fenced playground and one on the rest of the property behind the FLC for older children. Activities include: the egg hunt, games (board games, putt-putt, bean bag toss, croquet), food (hotdogs, hamburgers and drinks), prizes and an opportunity for parents to take photos of their children with the Easter Bunny.

In addition to church families, we plan to invite children from the four elementary schools served by ALBOH for after-school programs. We envision this to attract a large number of participants and families.

Approximately 10 - to 12 volunteers are needed to help hide the eggs, register the participants, supervise the search areas, staff the kitchen, assist in the game area (including playing / helping with the board games) in the FLC, and assist the Easter Bunny.

Once again, we are also asking for donations of non-meltable candies. Candies will be placed within plastic eggs. Individually wrapped miniatures like Tootsie Rolls, Starburst, Life Savers, etc. are the best choice.

Please drop candies off at the Narthex or the church office. We would like to get the candies packed in the plastic eggs by March 16<sup>th</sup>.
