Annual Easter Egg Hunt

Our annual Easter Egg Hunt was held on Saturday March 23rd between 10 AM and Noon. We had 27 children and their families. The children's ages ranged from 1 year old to 11 years old. A total of 2000 eggs with candy were hidden in the area behind the FLC, around the office (soon to be parsonage), and in the ALBOH playground. In addition, 45 special prize eggs were also hidden. The children were separated into two age groups with the younger children hunting in the ALBOH playground while the older children hunted in the FLC / office area. The special prizes included small toys, stuffed animals and gift cards all of which were made possible through donations by the congregation. After the egg hunt, the families were able to take photos of their children with the Easter Bunny and to participate in various activities which included coloring, a fishing game, bean bag toss, miniature golf and table bowling. We also provided hot dogs, chips, snow cones (which were a big hit with the children) and drinks. From the smiles on the children's faces and the wonderful comments from the parents, everyone seemed to have a very good time.

This event would not have been possible without the generous contributions and assistance of the members of our congregation. We gratefully thank everyone who participated, whether it was through candy and prize donations, stuffing eggs, staffing the kitchen, setting up and taking down the Egg hunting grounds, watching over the children during the hunt, staffing the games and offering their experience and guidance to the team organizers. A special thank you goes out to Lexie Otte for doing such an awesome job portraying the Easter Bunny and to her assistant, Lizzie.
